

# Renovation Household Appliances



### STEPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL PROJECT

This paint is designed for fridges, dishwashers and other aluminium, metal or plastic goods. It is NOT suitable for use on sealants, or high-heat goods such as ovens, microwaves, toasters etc. Surface PREPARATION is ESSENTIAL. See Step 1 below.

Optimum product performance and adhesion are achieved after 20 days from application. Treat the surface gently, avoiding direct impact, abrasion, staining or cleaning, for the first 20 days after application.

#### > STEP 1 - PREPARATION

ALUMINIUM, METAL, STAINLESS STEEL: degrease with acetone then allow to dry.

SMALL PLASTIC SURFACES: wash, rinse thoroughly with water, allow to dry. Lightly sand (240 grit) and remove dust.

WASHING the surface with a soda-based (alkaline) cleaner is essential.

Greasy or plastic-coated surfaces can affect the adhesion of the paint.

## > STEP 2 - APPLICATION

#### Tools

Paint mixer or wide stick • Paint roller & brush (for angles, corners, joints & finishes)

Before applying, stir the paint with a mixer or wide stick, working around the bottom of the tin to mix it well. This is a ready-to-use product, do not dilute.

- 1. Start by painting the angles, corners and joints of the surface with a brush.
- 2. Distribute the paint evenly on a roller and apply the paint with vertical strokes. Follow with successive horizontal strokes, perpendicular to those just applied.
- 3. Finish with further vertical strokes for perfect results.

To achieve the best results in terms of performance and resistance, two coats of paint are essential.

Touch dry: 2 hours - Recoat: 12 hours - Fully dry: 24 hours. For bright colours, dark or porous surfaces, it may be necessary to apply an additional coat.

Interior use only • Before applying the paint, cover any areas of the surface or surroundings that are not being painted • Work on small surfaces (0.5-1m<sup>2</sup>) • Do not exceed the recommended coverage rate • Do not apply the product either too thickly or too thinly • Apply the paint between 12 and 25 °C and avoid draughts • Do not stop applying the product in the centre of a surface • Do not start reapplying the product while it's still drying • Remove as much paint as possible from brushes and rollers before washing. Clean your tools with water • To clean painted surfaces, use a gentle detergent. Do not use abrasive sponges
