PREPARATION

Preparation is an ESSENTIAL stage.

- POROUS TIMBERS (unfinished timber, mdf, etc.): Sand down the base surface and remove dust.
- LACQUERED TIMBERS: Wash with a soda-based (alkaline) cleaner, rinse with copious amounts of fresh water and allow to dry. Lightly sand down the base surface using 240 grade sand paper and remove dust.
- PLYWOOD, VENEERS OR MELAMINE-COATED BOARDS: Wash with a soda-based (alkaline) cleaner, rinse with copious amounts of fresh water and allow to dry
- WAXED TIMBERS: Remove wax, rub down base surface and remove dust

PERFORMANCE

Easy Furniture is an opaque 3-in-1 varnish:

1. It bonds, without stripping, to lacquered or veneered surfaces to be revamped.
2. It embellishes and transforms your surfaces.
3. It is stain-resistant, and protects your furniture and woodwork against everyday wear and tear.

Easy Furniture is easy to apply, and provides a highly attractive finish. Easy to maintain and is washable.

APPLICATION

1. Stir product vigorously in order to ensure that the product is thoroughly mixed.

2. Apply a first thin coat using a brush, following the grain of the wood. Leave to dry for 4 hours.

3. Apply a second coat by the same method. Leave to dry for 12 hours. For large

vertical surfaces, application in 2 coats using a lacquer roller is recommended. For bright colours, an additional coat may be required. As this lacquer achieves optimum hardness after 20 days, the base surface should be protected (against impacts, stains, etc.) for the first 20 days.

Coverage instructions for the product should be observed - avoid applying the

lacquer too thickly or too thinly. Lacquer should be applied at an optimum temperature between 12° and 25°C in still conditions. Do not reapply to a finish

which is already drying. Clean tools in water. Clean finished surfaces using a mild detergent. Do not use abrasive sponges.
